ABOUT

Meyler Campbell's Team Coaching Programme - **Unlimited** - is designed to expose professional coaches to the best practice principles, models, tools, and techniques of, and thinking behind, team coaching.

PROGRAMME DESIGN

The Unlimited programme comprises two core modules and three focused modules supported by supervision. The path to accreditation requires that all five modules are taken in addition to the Team Coaching Project, participation in Supervision, and the completion of the Experience and Learning Record. The path to qualification is described and illustrated in the Appendices.

These five modules form the basis of the learning approach for the programme and participants are required to take them sequentially:

MODULES OF THE UNLIMITED PROGRAMME

TEAM COACHING FUNDAMENTALS

Explores the key differences between team coaching and individual coaching and introduces the Parameters of Team Coaching.

PARAMETERS OF TEAM COACHING

Introduces the ways in which the framework can be used to inform each step of the team coaching process from contracting through to intervention

TEAMS IN CONTEXT

Deploys a systems thinking approach to explore the influence of context on a team.

TEAMS AND INDIVIDUALS

Mapping, appraising, identifying individual differences and the impact on team's performance, and/or looking at the team as a whole.

TEAM DYNAMICS

Introduces a psychological perspective to provide coaches with techniques to enhance their ability to coach teams to high performance and sustained change.

TEAM COACHING PROJECT

To qualify as an Unlimited Coach, participants are required to complete a project to demonstrate their ability to coach a team from contracting to intervention worked up into a 1500-word case study. This should include the use of a team psychometric and at least one Meyler Campbell tutor-observed team coaching session.

SUPERVISION

To supplement and support the work undertaken during the modules, participants will have the opportunity to join group and individual supervision sessions with a Meyler Campbell tutor throughout the programme. These sessions can be used for further learning and to discuss the Team Coaching Project.

EXPERIENCE AND LEARNING RECORD

The programme combines theory and practice, and participants are required to record their observations of both their learning during the modules as well as the work they are completing externally in live team coaching situations. The learning record will also include reflections on the theories discussed, reading reviews, notes from supervision and a log of team coaching undertaken.

QUALIFICATION

Participants will be eligible to qualify as an Unlimited Team Coach on completion of all five modules, the Team Coaching Project, the Supervision sessions and the Experience and Learning Record. They will finally be invited to attend a Business Panel at which they will present a summary of their learning journey and their proposed next steps.

WHO IS IT FOR?

Unlimited is designed for experienced and qualified coaches. There will be 12 coaches participating in each cohort which will be led by two Meyler Campbell tutors.

DATES

Dates are set prior to the start of an Unlimited programme. Taking place in Central London, next dates are set to start in Spring 2025.
